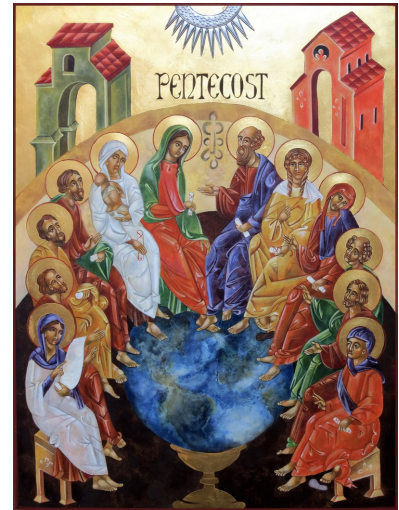

About Today's Service

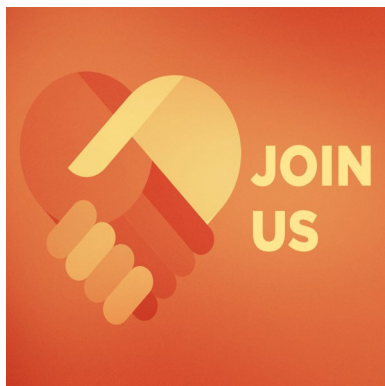
